DAY 4: For God’s will to be accomplished through our church.
(See *Hebrews 13:20-21*)

DAY 5: For our trust to rest fully and completely on the Lord. (See *Proverbs 3:5-6*)

DAY 6: Our hearts and motives would honor God and help others. (See *1 Corinthians 10:31*)

DAY 7: For strength and equipping as we face hardships and trial. (See *Psalms 46:1-3*)

PRAY:

DAY 8: Our worship would be filled with thanksgiving and praise. (See *Psalm 100:4*)

DAY 9: For people to know the power of the cross. (See *1 Corinthians 1:18*)

DAY 10: Our motivations are rooted in absolute surrender to Christ. (See *Romans 12:1*)

DAY 12: For a passion to lean into God's word daily. (See *Joshua 1:8*)
